Community Facilities Committee Report to Council September 2022

- 1. Access to the Mountford Sports Field. This work will go ahead at the end of September. The cricket club have offered to pay for the speed signs and the speed hump.
- 2. Dog Close:
 - There was much public input into this. The main issue seems to be that they are not against there being no dogs allowed but that they want a lead free dog area somewhere in the village. Please see the recommendation.
 - Access gate is still an issue.
 - A list of potential names has been compiled. We ask councillors to comment, add and then agree to hold a public vote.
 - The committee has accepted another bench for the area.
 - Further shrubs and trees are due for delivery in October.
 - Councillors have been a given a copy of the Working Group's five year plan. This plan is constantly changing.
- 3. Transfer of land: our solicitor has received the documentation for the first two parcels of land at The Grange.
- 4. Our contractors have submitted a quote for ongoing maintenance on these areas once handed over (see below).
- 5. The committee reviewed the position regarding the land at Frost Road.
- 6. The committee has accepted the offer of a 7 foot ash tree for Dog Close.
- 7. The programme of visits to the properties owned, leased by the Council will start again this Autumn. The dates are to be arranged.
