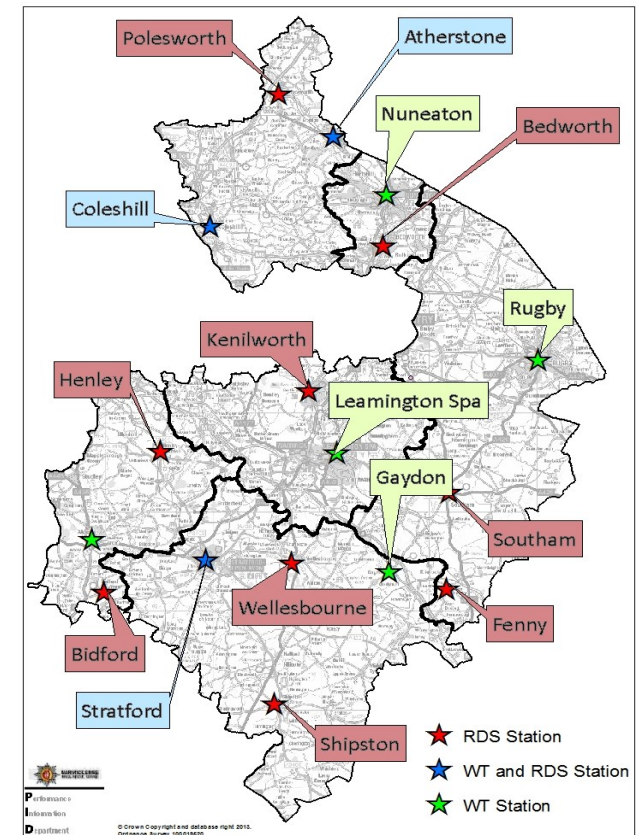

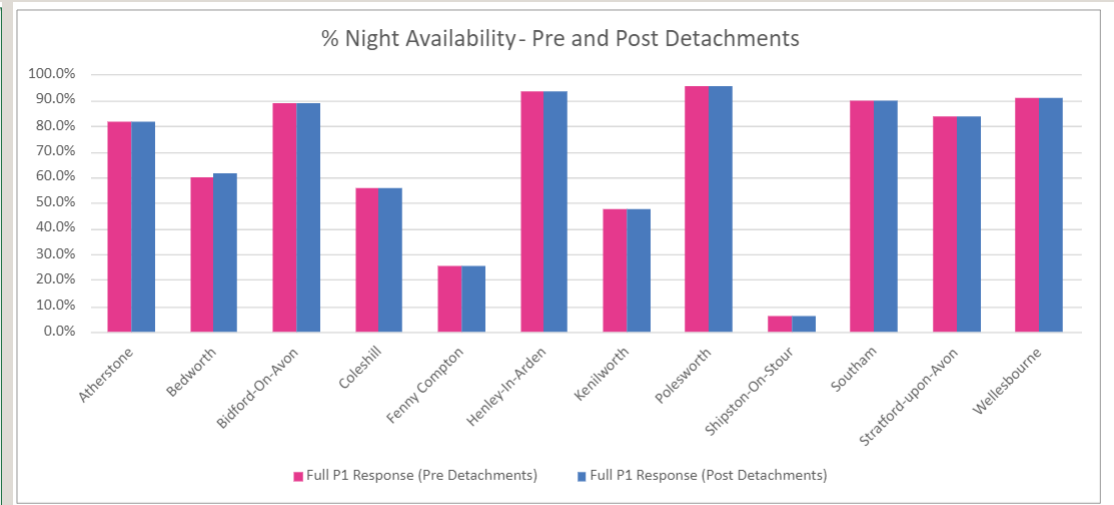
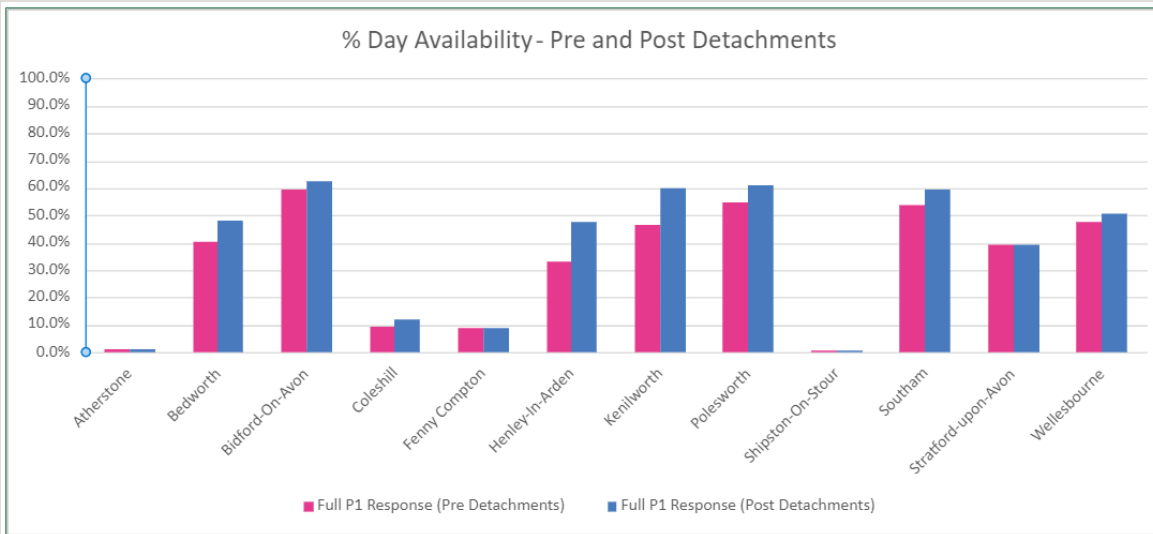


- **ON-CALL FIRE STATIONS**
