This is overdevelopment of the site and totally out of character with the existing street scene, the design is for a detached property where all others are semi detached so is out of context with other properties in the area, the plot is too close to the A429 bypass road (removing the shelterbelt buffer to the noise from the road), would have a detrimental effect on the neighbouring properties which because the adjoining road is set at a 90\* angle would make their windows face a two storey brick wall, there is no parking provision for the proposed detached 2 bed property where there should be a minimum of two spaces provided and sufficient parking is already lacking at 25 Manston Drive where the garden has been removed to put slabs for parking one vehicle which it is uncertain as to whether the hard standing was installed without proper planning consent.
